Dear EMS Community:

Included in this packet is our MCC Summer EMS Educational Offering for courses starting in and also the announcement of the EMS Scholarship Golf tournament. Please share these announcements with anyone who might be interested. Please read below for some additional EMS education information.

- Effective immediately, Monroe Community College Public Safety Training Center will only be offering one Paramedic Recertification Course each year. The course will be a Fall Semester course starting in early September and testing in December. This course will be offered in a hybrid format with both classroom and on-line lessons. This change is being made because of continuing decline in enrollment in the traditional Paramedic Recertification Course as more paramedics move into the Continuing Medical Education program and offering two classes a year is financially burdensome.
- MCC will continue to provide the AEMT Rapid Rectification Program for eligible Paramedics, AEMT-Critical Care and AEMT-Intermediate. The Rapid Rectification Program is for actively practicing AEMTs that have completed continuing education that is acceptable to their medical director. This program involves students taking both a written and practical skills exam. Students who would like to pursue this option for recertification; they should contact the MCC EMS Info line at [emsinfo@monroecc.edu](mailto:emsinfo@monroecc.edu).
- MCC has been asked by Monroe County –EMS Office to offer programs in Public Safety Incident Management (PSIM) and Mass Casualty Incident Management between now and late July. The tuition for these courses will be paid for by grant funds for approved EMS providers. Please pay attention for course announcements in the near future. We are planning and offering two sections of each class.
- All levels of EMS Education and Certification in New York State (and across the country) will have significant changes in the next two years. The official timeline has not been released by the Bureau of EMS, but unofficial discussions are leading to a transition date for the new EMS Education Standards for classes starting in January 2013. MCC is planning to begin offering courses based on the new Education Standards for classes beginning in January 2013. These courses are still be developed, but it appears that the courses will all be longer by up to 10 -15 %. As the transition plans become formalized by the Bureau of EMS, MCC will share them with the community so you can be prepared for these changes.

**PLEASE READ:**

Tuition support from NYS/EMS can only be provided for active members of EMS agencies which have a PCR agency code and participate in the PCR system. Students who are not affiliated with an EMS agency by the start date of the class are **NOT** eligible for tuition support from NYS/EMS. State funding is contingent upon continued availability of funds.

Tuition support will only be provided for students who pass the State (re) certification exam when taken on the scheduled test date for the course which he/she is registered. A student who fails or does not test on the original scheduled date will receive a tuition bill issued by the MCC Bursar's Office and is obligated to pay the tuition. A reimbursement from the Bursar's Office will be issued when (re)certification is obtained within one year of the original test date.
