The Public Safety Training Center in partnership with the Rochester Police Department, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the Monroe County Probation Department will conduct the GANG INVESTIGATIONS course. This course will be held at the Public Safety Training Facility, room 117B, 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, New York.

This seminar is limited to law enforcement personnel only.

The goal of this training is to familiarize the criminal justice personnel with contemporary gang trends, gang identifiers and officer safety concerns. Intervention and prevention strategies will also be covered during the seminar. This training will provide the students with an overview of prosecuting a gang case, interviewing gang members and understanding gang culture. Additionally, the course will discuss the following topics:

- Policy and legal implications of youth violence and gang behavior
- Local Gang activity and the social networking
- Western New York Region Gangs
- Prosecuting Gang cases
- Interviewing Gang members
- Gang's music and violence
- Rochester's Ceasefire (Gang Suppression)
- The impact of Gang activity on the Canada border

The instructors for the two day training will be veteran law enforcement personnel from the Rochester Police Department, Monroe County Sheriff's Department, and the Monroe County Probation Department. The City of Rochester's Pathways to Peace will also assist in the training.

Successful completion of this course will be worth 1.5 college credits from Monroe Community College.

Tuition for this course is \$192.00 per person plus \$54.50 in student fees. *A certificate of residency from out-of-Monroe county residents is required in order to avoid double tuition billing.* You will be billed at the completion of the course. It will not be necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.
