Police Supervision Course April 16th through May 4th, 2012 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM

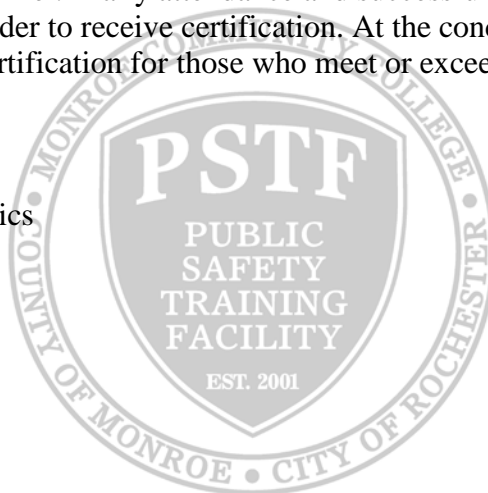
The Public Safety Training Center, in partnership with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, Office of Public Safety, will conduct the **POLICE SUPERVISION** course. This three week course will be held on the above dates and time at the Public Safety Training Facility, 1190 Scottsville Rd., Rochester, New York.

Becoming a first-line supervisor of law enforcement officers, as defined in section 209-q (2) (b) of the General Municipal Law, requires successful completion of this course as approved by the Commissioner of the Division of Criminal Justice Services. This course provides 105 hours of training pursuant to Section 6021 of Title 9, Subtitle U of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York

This course is designed for those law enforcement officers that have or will receive permanent appointment as a first-line supervisor. The Police Supervision Course is a mandatory requirement for any recently appointed supervisor of law enforcement personnel. Daily attendance and successful completion of academic and performance testing is required in order to receive certification. At the conclusion of this school the Executive Director of the MPTC will award certification for those who meet or exceed the above criteria.

- Communications
- Roles of the Supervisor
- Legal Issues
- Incident Management
- Community Relations
- Employee Assistance
- Terrorism
- Critical Incident Management
- Team Building



Successful completion of this course will be worth six (6) college credits from Monroe Community College.

Tuition for this course is \$768.00 per person plus \$97.00 in student fees. *A certificate of residency from out-of-Monroe county residents is required in order to avoid double tuition billing.* You will be billed at the completion of the course. It will not be necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.
